School District Provided Technology Device Agreement

Description of Item: This is a laptop computer. There are a variety of laptops in the district that will be loaned to the students. The cost of brand-new replacement would be \$606. The district will be prorating the potential cost of replacement based upon the device that is provided.

MIDDLE SCHOOL – Grades 6-8, Students in grades 6-8 are receiving new machines within a year old. The cost of these machines would be 75% of the total cost of replacement for those machines or \$455.

PRESCHOOL to GRADE 5 - Students in grades P-5 will be offered older machines. Given the age of these machines the district would prorate the cost of replacement to 40% of the value given the fact that the device is not new or \$242.

The power adapter and case are also being provided as noted below.

- 1. A school district provided technology device must be used only by the student for school district authorized use;
- 2. Any school district provided technology device loaned to a student must be returned to the school district in the condition it was initially provided to the student considering reasonable use and care by the student;
- 3. The parent or student shall be responsible to reimburse the school district the cost of any technology device that is lost, damaged beyond reasonable use or beyond its value, abandoned, missing, stolen, or cannot be returned to the district in accordance with the terms of this Lafayette School District Provided Technology Device Agreement;
- 4. Please select one of the following:

__Option A

The district requires the parent to purchase an insurance policy that would cover certain losses or damage to a technology device during the time period the student has possession of the device. The parent or the student shall pay any insurance policy required deductibles in the event of a loss. Proof of insurance shall be attached to this School District Provided Technology Device Agreement;

The district requires the parent to be responsible for any loss or damage to the technology device in accordance with the terms of this School District Provided Technology Device Form and shall reimburse the District for any technology device that is lost, damaged beyond reasonable use or beyond its value, abandoned, missing, stolen, or cannot be returned to the district in accordance with the terms of this Lafayette Township School District Provided Technology Device Agreement;

- 5. A student/parent/guardian will be required to report any hardware or software problems in the operation of the device to the superintendent / principal within two school days of the commencement of the problem;
- 6. A student/parent/guardian must report to superintendent / principal within two school days in the event the technology device has been damaged or is missing;
- 7. A student/parent/guardian is required to immediately file a police report in the event it is believed the technology device has been stolen. Within one school day after filing a police report, a student/parent/guardian shall submit a copy of the police report to the superintendent / principal;
- 8. The student shall have the technology device in their possession in school as required.

Anti-Big Brother Act, P.L. 2013, Chapter 44 and N.J.S.A. 18A: 34-1

We, the parent and student, acknowledge that we have been notified that the technology device provided by the school district may record or collect information on the student's activity or use of the technology device if the device is equipped with a camera, global positioning system, or other feature capable of recording or collecting information on the pupil's activity or use of the device.

We, the parent and student, acknowledge that the school district shall not use any of the capabilities in a manner that would violate the privacy rights of the student or any individual residing with the student.

Individual Responsibility

We, the parent and student, acknowledge that use of any network through the Device includes the potential for accessing web sites with inappropriate materials. It is the responsibility of all users to attempt to avoid these sites through prudent use of the Internet. If a student accidentally accesses one of these sites, they should immediately exit from the site and/or notify a staff member or parent.

Practice Personal Safety

We, the parent and student, acknowledge and affirm that no personal information, such as full names, home address, phone number or credit card numbers will be disclosed through the Device. We, the parent and student, further acknowledge and affirm that no arrangements for or actual face-to-face meeting with someone "met" on the internet will be made.

Warranties

The Lafayette Township School District makes no warranties of any kind, either express or implied, in connection with its provision of access to and use of the Device, its computer network and/or the internet provided herein. It shall not be responsible for any claims, losses, damages, or costs (including attorney's fees) of any kind suffered, directly or indirectly, by any user or his or her parents or guardians arising out of the user's use of its computer networks or the internet under this policy. By executing this Agreement, a user, or in the case of a user under 18, the parents/guardians are agreeing to indemnify and hold the school, the school district, the provider that provides the computer and internet access opportunity to the school district, and all of their administrators, teachers, staff, or any other agents of the Lafayette Township School District harmless from any and all loss, costs, claims, or damages resulting from their user's access to its computer network and the internet, and any use of the Device, including but not limited to, any fees or charges incurred through purchases of goods or services by the user. The user or, if the user is a minor, the user's parents/guardians agree to cooperate with the school in the event of the school's initiation of an investigation of a user's use of his or her access to its computer network and the internet, whether that use is on a school computer or on another computer outside of the Lafayette School District's network.

We, the parent and the student, have read the terms above, understand the terms, and agree to abide by these terms, and shall comply with all school district policies for the use of a school district provided technology device.
