BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Board establishes the statutory probationary period provided by NJSA 18A:28-5 as applicable to all assistant principals serving within the district for acquisition of tenure in the position of assistant principal; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this resolution shall have prospective effect only and shall not affect the tenure rights of any individual who acquired tenure under the previously board approved shortened tenure probationary period.
